The soup will be served in handcrafted bowls created by local artist Doug Kobs of Vernon as well as bowls donated from the organization’s various supporters. Additional bowls along with handcrafted plates will be available for sale at \$10 each.

Empty Bowls is an international grassroots effort to fight hunger.
