Chrysalis Center, Inc. Becomes Charity Organization of Choice for Temple Beth Hillel

South Windsor- Temple Beth Hillel of South Windsor, lead Rabbi Jeffrey Glickman, has chosen Chrysalis Center as its organization of choice for all charity and volunteer efforts in 2017.

“Every year we go in what is called a Shema tour,” says Rabbi Glickman. “This is where we go on a tour bus, go to charitable and non-profit organizations, and just listen to the needy. As part of the Reform Judaism movement, our primary focus is on how the world is and how it can be.” The Temple Beth Hillel congregation has been doing this for the last two decades, each time with a different organization.

“There were three main reasons for choosing Chrysalis. First, we could see that we could make an effective difference if we became involved. Then the talents of our patrons combined with what Chrysalis Center does were just a right fit for us. However, what really got us were there stories we heard from the Chrysalis staff. They truly touched all of us,” says Rabbi Glickman.

Temple Beth Hillel has been in South Windsor since 1957. The congregation is devoted to the enhancement of Jewish life, but welcomes and has activities for persons of all faiths. Judy Scott and Sharon Greenfield of the synagogue will be in charge of all activities the house of worship has with Chrysalis Center.
