



VOLUNTEER GUIDELINES DURING COVID-19

Chrysalis Center's priority is to keep all volunteers safe during this national emergency. The following are general guidelines for in person volunteerism to help keep you safe so you can help others, and so we all get through this crisis together.

In keeping with CDC Guidelines, volunteers must be 18 or older, and not at risk, including the following: those who are immunocompromised, showing symptoms of COVID-19, or live with or care for someone in any of those categories.

In addition to safety measures which have been in place since the onset of pandemic, we have increased our safety precautions, including:

- Volunteers must show proof of vaccine and provide a copy of their vaccination record for Chrysalis Center to keep on file.
- Face masks worn in all public areas, including Freshplace, hallways and other shared areas.
- Do NOT show up to volunteer for any activity if in the last 14 days you have:
 - Traveled to any foreign country or large metropolitan city
 - Been exposed to anyone who has COVID-19.
 - Attended an event indoors where there was more than 250 people.

General Guidelines for On-Site Volunteers:

- Do NOT show up to volunteer for any activity without an online volunteer form completed. Form can be found here: <https://chrysaliscenterct.org/get-involved/volunteer-form/>
- DO practice universal infection control precautions. Clean and wash your hands before, during, and after volunteering.
- DO use proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) if needed for the task.
- ASK about any risk that may be associated with the task and DO NOT take part if you are uncomfortable with the level of risk.
