Chrysalis Center Recognized as Top 3% in Nation for all Health and Human Services Nonprofits

Hartford, CT – The [Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities](#) (CARF) International has announced that Chrysalis Center, Inc. has received the highest recommendation for a period of three years for its Community Case Management, Supportive Housing Services and Community Integration Services. With over 1400 standards, Chrysalis Center only received 2.5 recommendations, placing them in the top 3% of all health and human service nonprofits in the nation and internationally.



This accreditation decision represents the *highest* level of accreditation that can be awarded to an organization and shows the organization's substantial conformance to CARF standards. An organization receiving a Three-Year Accreditation has put itself through a rigorous peer review process and has demonstrated to a team of surveyors during an on-site visit that its programs and services are measurable, accountable, and of the highest quality.

The latest accreditation is the seventh consecutive Three-Year Accreditation CARF has awarded to Chrysalis Center.
